TURTLE NESTING SEASON



If you are lucky enough to be on the beach while turtles are nesting please follow these guidelines



Avoid off-track driving specially in the beaches of the Red Sea



As soon as the turtle is spotted at the beach, move away to a distance of at least 20 meters.



If the event is occurring during night-time, keep all lights off and do not spot the light at the turtle eyes.



Avoid photography with flash! The flash-light could disturb or disorient the turtle.



Always stay behind the turtle where she can't see you.



Don't try to touch the turtle or move it from its original position



If you think that the turtle is in distress, DO NOT intervene. The best is to inform the authorities immediately
